

ACUA has received information that a credit union ATM has been the subject of an ATM jackpotting theft. The top portion of the ATM was broken into and a USB drive inserted in the ATM computer. This device/program forced the ATM to dispense all its cash.

Credit unions may wish to carefully check their ATMs for any signs of tampering. In the case mentioned, the criminals glued the alarm sensor closed so it would not go off again. This allowed them to gain access again without worry of police returning.

Resources state these type criminals tend to travel along interstates and hit ATMs along the way.
